Cost will be £2 per person, with £1 going to Cuffley Great Wood and £1 going to St Elizabeth's, the Group's nominated charity.</p> <p><i>St George's Day Parade (Sunday 26<sup>th</sup> April)</i> The date of Sunday 26<sup>th</sup> April for this event was noted.</p> <p><i>AGM (Friday 12<sup>th</sup> June)</i> It was decided that this year's AGM will be held on Friday 12<sup>th</sup> June. (This date, which is later than in previous years, allows the annual accounts to be formally approved ahead of the AGM in the June Exec meeting on 08/06/15.)</p> <p><i>Early-May Bank Holiday Camp</i> Whether or not this event is held will depend on whether or not all sections are able to attend the District Cub Camp in June – see item 6.7 .</p> <p><i>North London District Camp (Friday 22<sup>nd</sup> May – Monday 25<sup>th</sup> May, Tolmers)</i> The Group will be attending this event. Approximate cost will be £60, although this may be lower for Beavers, who will not be attending the full event.</p> <p><i>District Cup Camp (Friday 19<sup>th</sup> June – Sunday 21<sup>st</sup> June, Well End, Borehamwood)</i> The site's cost will be £25 per person. It is hoped that all sections will be able to attend, in which case the Group will not also hold an early-May Bank Holiday camp.</p> <p><i>Scout Summer Camp (Saturday 25<sup>th</sup> July – Saturday 1<sup>st</sup> August)</i> It has not yet been decided where to go, CK will be making a decision imminently.</p>	<p>CK</p>
